COVID-19 has hurt the outreach of the church in so many ways, but God continues to call us to be salt and light in this community. We feel like God has truly been Immanuel as He is leading us into new ministry areas that we had never considered before. Thanks for partnering with us and helping bring the light of Christ to a vital but hurting community!
