We were also able to get packing done with less stress since there were many weeks that we were unable to have people over. Packing out of the hospitality house was complicated, as there were many items we wanted to leave for those continuing the ministry after us, as well as packing personal items. Although it just might

provided friendships for our kids. Alethia (eighth grade) and Masami (sixth grade) are doing hybrid school, which has hindered their ability to make new friends, but it is happening ever so slowly and we are thankful for the few social media platforms that have allowed them to continue friendships from a distance. Elise (pre-K) has a built-in playmate in her cousin who lives only minutes away.

We are slowly transitioning into our new jobs. Anthony, as a recruiter, is feeling excited about getting to network with



schools and churches to talk to folks about ministry. We long for the day that travel restrictions will be lifted and he will be able to do more of his job in person, rather than virtually. Jessica is enjoying starting to coach new missionaries as they begin their partnership development and get ready to head to the field. We were able to be a part of Cadence’s fall candidacy and appoint several new missionaries. So exciting to see new workers for the Kingdom!

We continue to rely on your support and financial partnership. Although we are now in the States, our salary and ministry expenses will continue to be funded through donations. We have been very blessed that COVID-19 has not impacted our support team significantly, however, we need to raise an additional \$1,000 in monthly support, as well as \$10,000 in moving/transition expenses.
