However, she has been on meds that have helped her body function with the stone. Right now, we are waiting and praying the stone will dissolve on its own. She may still need surgery, but we are thankful we've been given time for her to get bigger and grow older.

Through this whole process, God has been close to Amy and me, and we have felt so supported by friends and family. We ask that you continue to pray that God will remove the stones and Mika will be healed.
