

Hello! My name is Tori Randall. I am currently a junior at the Moody Bible Institute in downtown Chicago studying Human Services. I have the incredible opportunity to serve with Cadence International in North Carolina this upcoming summer. Cadence International is an evangelical mission agency dedicated to reaching the military communities of the United States and of the world with the Good News of Jesus Christ. Cadence missionaries also come alongside military chaplains by providing support, solid Christian community, and discipleship for those serving on bases around the world.

I first heard about Cadence International through a friend I met at Moody, but it did not spark my interest until I went to Israel on study abroad in the Spring of 2020. While I learned a lot of rich spiritual truths, seeing those who served in the military there stuck with me. In Israel everyone is required to serve in the military for two years after high school. I wrestled a lot with this, knowing that God did not build me for the military. However, through this I gained a desire to serve those who do choose to serve their country in this way.

When I got back to the States, I applied to intern with Cadence International so that I can learn how to serve and love well those who sacrifice so much for others. This summer I get to bring Christ's love to military families, specifically working with young adults and teenagers. God has been so faithful up to this point, and I am thrilled to see what else He has in store this summer.

This summer I will be serving at a hospitality house near Ft. Bragg in North Carolina. In a Cadence hospitality house, military personnel and their families find a welcoming smile, a comfortable couch, a home-cooked meal, and people who listen, love, and guide them to Christ. I will be working with a missionary family who serves full-time at the hospitality house, along with one



other intern. I will be helping plan community events, building relationships, encouraging Soldiers, and pouring into several teenage girls whose parents serve at Ft. Bragg. I am extremely excited to love and care for those serving in the military this coming summer.

As I get ready to leave for North Carolina I would like to ask for your prayers, because it is only by the grace of God that people will come to know and love Him more.
