One of things I will be doing with Cadence is developing our internship program. You may be asking, "Why are internships important?" You have probably heard me say joining missions is like joining the military. Sound crazy? There is lots of paperwork, it takes months to start the job, training is required, and usually, people do not understand exactly what they have signed up for. This is why internships

are important. Interns get to "try out" Cadence to see if the ministry is a good fit for them. Over the summer, an intern is discipled and trained by full-time missionaries, sometimes living with them. They see up close both the amazing and difficult aspects of ministry. I started out as an intern, and I am not alone.

Here is another story of an intern-turned-missionary. Savanna fell in love with missions at age 15. Currently, she is a Cadence intern at Joint-Base Lewis McCord (JBLM) in Washington serving in a hospitality house. She is really excited about this opportunity and feels that this is another chance to work in God's kingdom and experience growth as she prepares to do full-time youth ministry in Japan as a Cadence missionary. She envisions her ministry as coming alongside young people and walking with them where they are in life, while also sharing the gospel and living her life as an example of Christ. Cadence is thrilled and blessed to have her.









SUPPORT UPDATE

God has worked mightily through many of you. Thank you for your prayers and sacrificial giving. I am approximately \$400 per month away from being released to ministry, which means I will move from support raising to mobilizing. I will help recruit and send more workers and interns, as well as share about Cadence's vision for the military, and I can't wait to start! By December I will need an additional \$900 in monthly support for insurance.

If 11 more people come alongside as battle buddies for \$100 a month, then this would cover the *entire* need. Would you prayerfully consider if God is calling you to this?
