The other night I was organizing all my paintings from the past year and realized it's been almost one year since I flew back to the states for home assignment. Each painting holds a story from this past year, a moment in time. I came back from overseas battling chronic fatigue, exhausted from goodbyes, and needing rest.

Today, as I enjoy the warmth of this June day and am once again painting, I am reminded that there are seasons when the Lord invites us to lie down in green pastures near waters of rest where He can restore our souls. The past year has been one of challenge but also rest. There have been days when resting has been







the last thing I've wanted to do, yet I can say confidently that I'm in a new place with my fatigue. I am not being held back by my body's exhaustion the way I used to be, and I have found confidence and rest in the Father as I hike, paint, and read.

The plan is to begin working with the Cadence Mobilization team beginning in July. I've been able to be a part of a few meetings this spring to talk through recruiting and internships. I look forward with excitement to this new position, which will be a key part in helping send out new Cadence missionaries around the world. I am honored

that you are prayerfully supporting me as I recruit more harvesters for the fields.

In addition to resting, I've also had to spend this season raising support to take on this new role. Friends, we were able to raise \$1,400 of monthly support over the course of nine days in May! This was made possible through your prayers and your willingness to say yes to the Lord to be a part of my support and sending team! The Lord has been providing in AMAZING ways.



I still need \$1,000 per month before July 1, otherwise, I cannot start my new position. I am praying for ten individuals who will step up and be willing to send me out at \$100 a month. If you are not currently giving, would you consider being one of those ten people supporting me at \$100 per month?

If you are not currently in a place to give monthly or are already giving, would you pray about giving a one-time gift or increasing your support by even \$25 per month? Every little bit gets me closer to my goal so I can be released to the Mobilization team!

I want to finish this letter off with a quick story. Last month, as I first began to push for all my support to be in by June 1, I wrestled with doubt that God could do it in such a short amount of time. I should have known what God could do! I began to receive texts from friends saying, "June 1. We are praying you are fully supported by June 1." I opened emails which read, "We are praying," and "We have decided to start giving."

All those messages, all those emails and calls not only encouraged me but spoke out against my own doubt. The Holy Spirit used each of

you this year to encourage me, speak life into my exhausted soul, and point me back to Jesus regularly. I'm so thankful for each of you and cannot wait to continue to do ministry alongside you!
