You may remember Laura's testimony from my Christmas letter. Well, much has happened since December. She graduated from college and has decided to intern with Cadence. I will let her tell the rest:

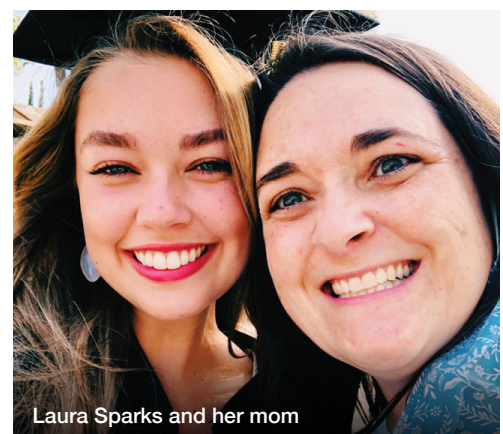
UPCOMING TRAVELS
