Recently a close friend at our men's group shared how the Holy Spirit prompted him to share a "Biker Bible" with an atheist high school friend named Bryan. He did his best to keep in contact with him, but seven months later heard that Bryan had contracted COVID-19 and died soon afterward. Our friend was heartbroken to hear the news, so decided to tune into the funeral on Facebook. To his amazement, it was a very God-focused service, and the minister shared that Bryan had turned his life over to the Lord about three months prior! God had placed that Bible and the faithful witness of four people into his life: his cleaning lady, his accountant, our friend, and a builder he hired, who eventually witnessed his repentance and turn to God!

As you can imagine, the recent happenings in Afghanistan have hit especially close to home in the military community. We are all praying for friends and family to return home safely and are feeling the weight of the last 20 years come to a dramatic close.
