OUR YEAR IN REVIEW Growth (Acts 2:42)

Our numbers have been up and down all year but we're happy to report they are presently up. In September, we received singles sent to us from other Cadence ministries who have jumped right in. Since then, they have invited several more singles, and now our group is about half families and half single active duty servicemembers. We also have at least two regular attendees who we know are not yet believers but they are asking questions and interested in knowing more about Jesus. Women's Ministry & Children's Ministry Relaunch

Our situation reminds me of the Bible verse that Cadence has adopted as a mission: "Because we loved you so much, we were delighted to share


