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Conference Attendance

It is expected that *all Cadence staff will be attending* this important conference, and it is highly encouraged that parents do everything possible to have your children in attendance with you. (If this is your first Cadence worldwide conference, just ask any Cadence kid who attended the 2010 or 2015 conferences how important this is, and you will receive the motivation you need!) Young adult children of staff (college and twenties) are also welcome.

We are also hopeful that many of our Ambassadors, part-time staff, Cadence Associate Field Staff, Cadence board members, missionaries in partnership development, and limited-term staff will attend as they are able.

If you have a challenge or conflict with either you or your spouse attending, we expect that you will discuss this with your field leader/supervisor with the determination to find solutions together to resolve the conflict or challenge. (For instance: If you are a spouse who works in another job outside of Cadence either part-time or full-time, please plan now for vacation time for these days of conference.) We know some of you may also be dealing with country restrictions related to Covid. If no solution can be reached after extensive dialogue, then the field leader/supervisor may grant permission for a staff member to not attend.

Registration FAQ

All three of the registration links contain the same general information. We have separated the groups so that you will see total costs calculated based on the length of stay at the conference center.

The process should be straight-forward; however, here are additional notes that may help you in your selections:

1. Your registration begins by **selecting the number of people attending conference**. This will route your registration with appropriate housing, meal, and program options.
2. **Lodging Options.** There are several accommodation selections available on the registration form; however, based on your household size, some will be more appropriate for you to select than others. You may see pictures of the specific buildings on the Green Lake website (glcc.org). NOTE: With the exception of a camping option or Lone Tree Lodge, the exact building will be assigned to you once registration has closed.

Lone Tree Lodge: Located a half mile from the main conference area, this option has single beds with a private bathroom. This is a great option if you would like a roommate. (Lone Tree Lodge is not an option displayed for couple or family registrations.)

Main Hotel Rooms (*Bauer, Kern, Lawson, and Roger Williams*):

These rooms are located near the main conference center and offer a variety of bed options. These rooms could be shared with a roommate. You will be assigned the most appropriate room based on your household needs. For those families who have more than six people, your total cost will be emailed to you after your registration is complete. We will work with you to ensure that you are comfortable and have enough space for your family.

Camping: There are camping sites with full electric and water hookups available. Please keep in mind that these are a distance from the main meeting area. Pets may stay at the campground; however, animals are not allowed in the main conference facilities or grounds.

Please communicate on your registration if you need a **handicap accessible room** or if you have **children** with you who you prefer to **not share a bed**. We have a limited number of rooms that will accommodate kids in separate beds and priority will be given to families with children of opposite genders. Thank you for your understanding as we work to meet everyone's needs.

3. **Meal Plans.** Be sure to complete the **Green Lake online form** to communicate dietary notes for you or any member of your family. All meals will begin with dinner on the day of your arrival and go through breakfast on Friday, July 1.
4. Additional sections of the registration will allow you to select your **t-shirt(s)** size(s), **breakout session ideas**, **payment selection**, and a **release** for images, video, and audio that is taken during the conference. You'll also have an opportunity to share comments with the conference team.
5. **Conference Fees.** Your conference fee is auto-calculated by the following: One attendee: \$300, Two attendees: \$350; Three attendees: \$400; Four or more attendees: \$450. These fees assist in covering conference expenses.
6. **Conference Total.** Once you have completed your selections, your conference total will appear near the end of your registration. This does not include your travel expenses.
7. **Early arrivals and late departures.** If you are planning to arrive before the conference begins or stay beyond breakfast on Friday, July 1, please contact the Green Lake Conference Center directly (920.294.3323) to make your extended reservations.
