We are thrilled to share with you that we are nearly funded for our ministry; only 28% to go! Our season of partnership development is almost over, and we are looking forward to transitioning into full-time house ministry at Camp Humphries in South Korea! Our hopeful plan is to be at the Humphries Hospitality House by July. We have been working hard toward this goal ever since we felt called into ministry in the Spring of 2018, and it is so amazing to see all the pieces start to come together.

The beginning of the year hit a bit of a snag as COVID-19 slowly made its way through our house. Just when we thought we were finally over it, someone else would come down with a fever. Thankfully, it is over now, we have no long-lasting symptoms. We have been able to get back to school, fundraising, and traveling.

And when we finally flew into Charlotte in the middle of the night, Jeff’s brother and his wife were able to put us up for the night before we drove home late the next day. God is so good. Our goal is June 1, which is coming up quickly!
