The power went out one night for Letty when I was not home, and she immediately became worried for her safety. She got up to see what it might have been and was instantly comforted by the brightness of the moon! We, like the moon, bring comfort to a dark world. We are not the light but are simply reflecting the Son. Here are some recent reflections.

Letty and some ladies from the chapel Bible study had the chance to bring a Thanksgiving meal to an outreach mission in Antwerp, helping women caught in prostitution. Seeing the joy and hope on the faces of the enslaved ladies who were blessed by this ministry was worth the effort.

Dwight has been encouraged by the growth in the men's group, with changed hearts and strengthened marriages as a result. One of the men shared that "it's a place where men can be open and real. If we can't be in a place where we can be ourselves, then we don't feel accepted. It's only then we can be open to learning about being better men, better husbands, and better Christians."

Letty had the opportunity to share with fellow Cadence missionary ladies at a European retreat. She taught a method of prayer and meditation that allows our minds to stay focused on God instead of getting distracted by outside influences. Letty was encouraged that one of her close friends taught her boys to pray this way. Now they don't want to go to sleep without their time in prayer.

As we pack up and prepare to transition back to stateside ministry, Letty has decided to stop her nursing role of caring for the sick and elderly in a nearby town. One of Letty's clients shared in a farewell letter to her that "it feels like you work with not only your hands but your heart. You are definitely carved from a different piece of wood (a Dutch saying)! When you come up the stairs singing, it's like the









sun is shining inside my room!" We both know that it is the Son who has been shining inside her room.

As we enter this Christmas season, may we all be looking for ways to reflect God's glory in a dark world. Pray with us as we wrap up our time here in Europe that we may finish strong and that the ministry here will continue on. We are excited to also connect with our Dutch supporters to share our vision as we transition to stateside military ministry. Thank you for partnering with us as we reflect His glory to the military community around us.
