My time with the young adult group has also been extra sweet these past few months. I have had opportunities to meet more unbelieving Sailors and have been working to build relationships with them, which has been such a fun adventure. The relationships I've built with the Sailors who attend the house are friendships I believe I'll have for the rest of my life. It has been such a gift to work and serve with the Blookers in a place where "the harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few."

When I first arrived, leaning in and getting to know the people here was not easy as an American civilian who was fresh out of Bible School. But by the time May rolled around and culture shock began to lift, I realized how much I had really come to love the military folks in Rota. Some

So, through lots of tears, phone calls, and even more prayers, I have decided to defer grad school for another year and extend my full-time military ministry in Rota until August 2024. I will no longer be homeschooling Hope and Jess, which will free me up to devote all my time to youth and women's ministry, which I am **so** excited about. I will continue to lead a high school girls' Bible study and help Preston (the youth pastor on base) with the youth group. I'll remain involved in the Villa Young Adult ministry, building relationships and connections, and continue to jump in and fill other needs as they come up!
