I am writing to share about an exciting ministry opportunity I'm getting ready to enter. I will be serving with Cadence International alongside the Bloker family in Rota, Spain, helping to homeschool their two daughters this coming school year. In addition, I will be assisting in their ministry to U.S. military personnel and the families stationed there.



Cadence International is an evangelical mission agency dedicated to reaching U.S. and foreign military personnel and their families with the good news of Jesus Christ. Founded in 1954, Cadence's mission is to "share the gospel and our lives with the military community."

Ben and Melody Bloker have been missionaries with Cadence International for eight years and have served in Rota for about a year, where they open their hearts

and home to the military community. The Victory Villa Hospitality House serves as a "home away from home" for military personnel and families based at Naval Station Rota through group meals, Bible studies, discipleship, and many fellowship events. Their ministry is full and fruitful! There aren't many schooling options in the area for their two daughters, Hope (16) and Jess (13), so stepping in to homeschool their girls will give Ben and Melody more time and energy to pour into their ministry.



I chose to serve with Cadence because of my experience with the military growing up. Now that I'm older, I see how difficult it would have been to move to a new place without the safety net of the other military families doing the same thing. The military community is a guaranteed network of eager people with a similar desire for relationships, and I am excited to help facilitate those connections. I look forward to working closely with and learning from Ben and Melody, as well as supporting them. I can't wait to see God work firsthand in Rota.

My ministry in Spain cannot be done alone—I need partners. Would you consider joining me? I am hoping to leave for Rota in mid-October. I need to raise \$4,200 in monthly support, as well as \$5,000 in special gifts to cover all of my expenses, including travel, visa, ministry, and a small salary. I also need prayer partners who will be committed to lifting me up to the Lord in prayer while I am there.
