

# Anthony & Jessica AMOR

Fall is in full swing! The kids are back in school, and Cadence is entering its next recruiting season. We had a good summer helping to coach new missionaries and interns in partnership development and fieldwork.

As you all know, we have been involved in full-time ministry with Cadence for twenty years. For ten years, we ran youth groups in Wiesbaden and Kaiserslautern, Germany, ministering to American teenagers who were there because one or both of their

parents were serving in the U.S. military. For four years, we had an open home ministry to the military community in Grafenwoehr, Germany, where families, children, and singles were involved in Bible Studies, discipleship, and a variety of activities in which we shared the gospel and our lives with them.

Living overseas presented several challenges, which include navigating our children through the German school system, our ever-changing relationship with the chaplains and the military community, and finding our way through the German healthcare system as Anthony experienced very dangerous heart issues and needed ongoing care to recover fully. We are thankful for the care we received, but the German system is quite different, and the language barrier provided another level of difficulty for us.

We returned to the U.S. in August 2020 so our kids could attend American high school and Anthony could pursue health on multiple levels. Since moving back, we have been working in support roles at Cadence HQ. We have loved our time with Cadence and ministering to military families. We don't doubt that God has us in Denver for this time, but the desire of our hearts is to return overseas to frontline ministry to the military community, which we hope to do when Ali and Masami graduate from high school in 2027.

Being in Denver has presented us with challenges we were not fully prepared for when we returned from Germany. One of the biggest challenges we are facing is trying to balance our budget. Living in Denver has become increasingly more expensive than living in Germany. We have come to the realization that our current financial situation is not sustainable. We have total trust that God will provide what we need, but we are unsure how He will



provide. We are considering a couple of options, and we invite you to help us discern what the Lord has for us.

One option that would allow us both to continue ministry with Cadence is for each of you to raise your current financial support by \$50 per month (or join our team if you are not currently giving). The other option is that, for a time, Anthony would step away from ministry with Cadence and find other employment while Jessica continues in her role with Cadence.
