This year, I have the exciting opportunity to serve in a yearlong internship with Cadence International. Founded in 1954, Cadence is an evangelical mission agency dedicated to reaching U.S. and foreign military personnel and their families with the good news of Jesus Christ. Cadence's mission is to "share the gospel and our lives with the military community."

With a focus on adult ministry, I will partner with local Cadence staff, Bill and Diane Sperry, who serve near Luke Air Force Base in Litchfield, Arizona. During my internship, I will experience military ministry, be discipled in my walk with Jesus, and receive training to be better equipped for Kingdom work. I will join the Sperrys each Tuesday night as they open their home, The Well Hospitality House, and offer a homecooked meal, fellowship, and Bible study to military personnel and their families. I will also help with special events and provide support to the chapel ministry on base.

I have chosen to serve with Cadence because I have felt—and it has been confirmed to me over and over again—that the Lord is calling me to serve Him and others through ministry work. I have been seeking and eagerly awaiting where He would lead me. I had been in a season of praying and asking for clear direction for about nine months when I heard about Cadence. I quickly became excited about this ministry's mission and knew this was something God was asking me to pursue.

I love that Cadence serves and ministers to the military and their families, a group of people who so selflessly serve our country. I am so thankful for this opportunity! I am excited to learn what full-time ministry entails and gain hands-on experience. Since

I feel God is calling me into ministry and missions, I think this is the perfect chance to learn from those who have ministry experience and grow in my walk with the Lord.

I do not have any prior experience or knowledge about military life, but I look forward to learning about it. I have great respect and appreciation for our military and desire to support them through sharing the love of Jesus. I expect to learn and grow so much through this experience and eagerly anticipate whatever the Lord has in store for me.

My internship cannot be done alone. I need prayer and financial partners to make this possible. Would you consider joining me?
