


Dear family and friends,

Hi everybody! I wanted to let you know that Cadence International has invited me to be an Intern beginning this July, Lord willing. I have been assigned to Grafenwöhr, Germany, for my year-long internship. Let me tell you a little more about Cadence. It is an evangelical mission agency dedicated to reaching U.S. and foreign military personnel and their families with the good news of Jesus Christ. Founded in 1954, Cadence's mission is "to share the gospel and our lives with the military community."

With a focus on U.S. military communities, I will partner with local Cadence staff who serve near the U.S. Army Garrison Bavaria (Tower Barracks) in Grafenwöhr. During my internship, I will experience military ministry, be discipled in my walk with Jesus, and receive training to better equip me for Kingdom work.

I will spend most of my time working with Cadence Student Ministries, which reaches military students in grades 6-12 through relationships and programs designed to

spiritually receptive and eager for meaningful relationships. As I serve these teens, I will be equipped to teach the Bible, lead small groups, plan an outreach event, and develop fruitful relationships with them to encourage them toward Christ.

I have chosen to serve with Cadence because their ministry to the military is very personal and relational, and they have a heart to disciple people who, in turn, will be able to disciple others. I also really appreciate how they will be discipling me along the way, giving me valuable experiences for the future.



Now, to the part where God is working in me a lot. My internship cannot be done alone. I need prayer and financial partners. Prayers are always needed! And without finances, I cannot be effective either. I need to raise \$3,000 in monthly support and \$5,000 in one-time gifts by July 1 to participate in this unique ministry opportunity. It's uncomfortable for me to ask for this, but God has been doing His work to humble me and allow people to bless me. Scripture says, "It is more blessed to give than to receive." I can be a blessing to people while being on the receiving end.

The amount I need to raise includes all my travel and ministry expenses, as well as a small salary.
