Dear Teammates,

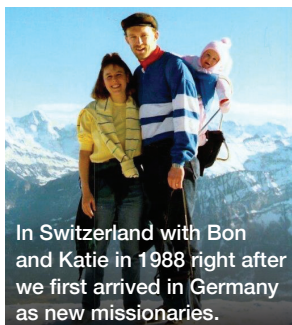

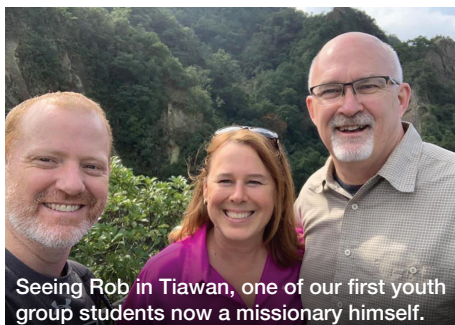

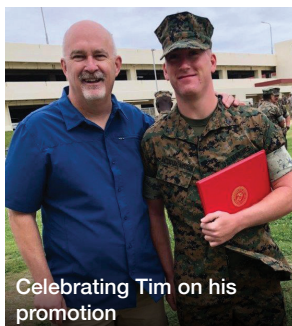
Being present when Keaton came home from Afghanistan

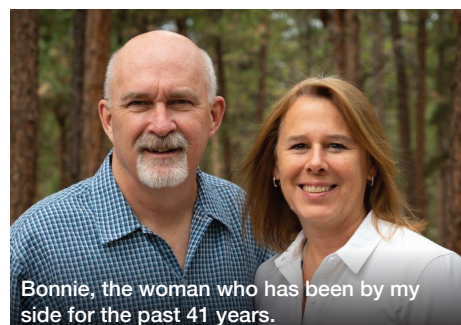
