This summer, I have the exciting opportunity to serve as an Intern with Cadence International. Cadence is an evangelical mission agency dedicated to reaching U.S. and foreign military personnel and their families with the good news of Jesus Christ. Founded in 1954, Cadence's mission is "to share the gospel and our lives with the military community."

With a focus on the U.S. military, I will partner with local Cadence staff who serve at a ministry called 47 NORTH near Naval Base Kitsap in Washington state. During my internship, I will experience military ministry, be discipled in my walk with Jesus, and receive training to be better equipped for Kingdom work.

I will assist Greg and Heidi Carlson, Cadence staff who have opened their

home as a hospitality house. The Cadence community at 47 NORTH is a "home away from home" or "a home one has never had" for active-duty Sailors, Marines, and their families. Other connections include a women's Bible study, one-on-one mentoring, and recreational activities every other month to deepen friendships. As I serve, I will be equipped to teach the Bible, lead small groups, plan an outreach event, and develop fruitful relationships with those in the military community. I have chosen to serve with Cadence because I want to get involved in military-focused ministry. I have a heart for the military because they are a unique people group in an environment filled with spiritual darkness. I want to be a light for Jesus in this community. I am excited to hear the stories of the Sailors I will be working with and get to

> know the missionaries I will stay with. This opportunity will help me grow in my hospitality skills and give me experience leading Bible studies. I look forward to seeing what the Lord has in store for me!
