As many of you know, my time in Spain ends on July 14, 2025. Thank you so much for riding this roller coaster with me as I have followed the Lord's call on my life to continue to serve in Spain. After serving as a limited-term missionary with Cadence International, I can confidently say that we do indeed serve a God who can do abundantly more than all we can ask or even think or imagine. The Lord used this experience to grow me into a leader who is passionate about creating spaces for people to interact with the living God and experience what the Christian community can and should be. As my time ends and the thought of civilian life sounds wonderfully boring, I am confident the Lord will continue to provide for the next adventure.



Although my assignment ends in July, my Cadence work account will not be closed until September 30 to allow for all of my final expenses to be processed. Any automatic withdrawals will continue to be taken until then unless you go in manually and cancel. Any remaining balance will be kept in my account in case the Lord calls me back into ministry with Cadence during the next year.
