Words will never be enough to capture what this ministry has done for me. The Vilseck House is more than just a house; it's a place where the love, presence, and peace of Jesus are felt the moment you walk through the door. Before coming here, I truly believed I could walk out my faith on my own. But Tina and Matt, their family, and the incredible community that fills this home showed me something different: that there is no Christian life without fellowship and genuine connection. 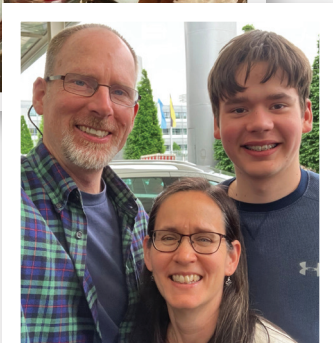
