Over the past few weeks, I've been reflecting on the concept of *provision*. As part of my role at Cadence, I help lead interviews for potential missionaries. One of the questions we ask is: "Tell us about a time you saw the Lord's provision." I've come to love this question—and even more, the answers I have the privilege to hear. People share stories from all seasons of their lives, each one a testimony of God's faithfulness. Let me share a few of my own.

This fall, I stepped into four weeks of travel within a six-week span. During those weeks, I spoke in one chapel, led two workshops, and visited five different classes to share about Cadence and the ministry we're doing around the world in the military community. That doesn't include the

60-plus students I've texted or the countless emails I've sent to set up calls and conversations about Cadence. Amid all of this, a sweet friend grounded me by simply meeting me where I was and being there for me during my travels. That was the Lord's provision.

I've also seen His provision through His answer to my prayers for new missionaries. Ten family units will attend our Spring Candidacy and are ready to say "yes" to sharing the gospel and their lives with the military community full-time. (This is huge, considering when I started praying, we had only one potential candidate!) As of this week, we have six more potential family units and a few more conversations in progress.
