

## Ralph & Betty Camp

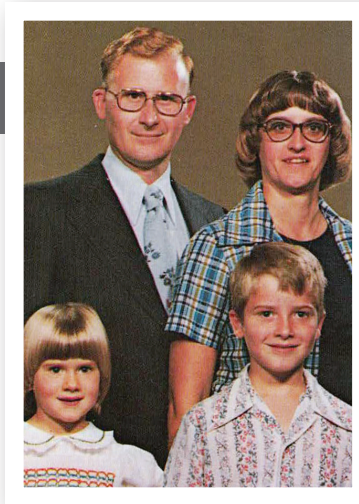
*Dear Friends,*

As you may have heard, Betty Camp was welcomed into heaven on March 14, 2026, surely greeted with the words, “Well done, my good and faithful servant.” We write to you knowing how deeply you have loved Ralph and Betty and how meaningful it has been to share in their long and fruitful ministry.

Ralph and Betty were a remarkable team who faithfully shared Christ with military personnel and their families in the Philippines, Japan, and the United States. Appointed with Cadence (then known as Overseas Christian Servicemen’s Center) on May 19, 1972, they began their ministry as assistant Directors at the Subic Service Center in the Philippines. In 1975, they stepped into leadership at the Sasebo Servicemen’s Center in Japan, where they continued serving at various posts in the country.

Betty was especially passionate about singing in choirs, mentoring young women, leading ladies’ Bible studies, and directing Sunday school and Vacation Bible School programs. She also served as an “HP Mom” with Hannah’s Prayer and as a case worker with the Navy-Marine Corps Relief Society, faithfully caring for those in need.

In 1983, the Camps returned to the United States to serve at Fellowship Ranch and later became the founding directors



of the Lemoore Hospitality House in California. Even in their Ambassador status with Cadence, Ralph and Betty remained deeply engaged in ministry—continuing to invest in the lives of others while relying on the faithful support of their community.

Some have asked whether Ralph will continue to receive financial support following Betty’s passing. The answer is yes. As Cadence Ambassadors, Ralph and Betty are part of a group of missionaries who, after many years of full-time service, transitioned to part-time ministry. Ambassadors continue to serve in ways that reflect their season of life, yet their commitment to sharing the gospel remains unchanged. They stay connected through field and worldwide conferences and continue as supported missionaries.
